RESOLUTION NO. 15 – 433

RECOMMENDING RAMON J.P. PAJE SECRETARY OF THE TO HON. DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES (DENR) THRU **ENVIRONMENT** MANAGEMENT BUREAU (EMB), **CORDILLERA** ADMINISTRATIVE REGION (CAR), THE DESIGNATION OF THE AMBURAYAN RIVER SYSTEM AS WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT AREA (WQMA) PURSUANT TO REPUBLIC ACT NO. 9275, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE PHILIPPINE CLEAN WATER ACT OF 2004

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9275, also known as the Clean Water Act of 2004, provides that the state shall pursue a policy of economic growth in a manner consistent with the protection, and revival of the quality of fresh, brackish, and marine waters within the framework of sustainable development;

WHEREAS, the designation of Water Quality Management Area has been identified as one of the main strategies for effectively enforcing the Clean Water Act and achieving an improvement in the water quality of our water bodies through focused interventions or actions that are designed to address specific water quality and quantity issues to such areas;

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the state to formulate a holistic national program of water quality management recognizing that water quality management issues cannot be separated from concerns about water sources and ecological protection, water supply, public health and quality of life, and to provide for comprehensive management program for water pollution through pollution prevention;

WHEREAS, as a matter of policy and strategy to protect and sustainably manage the country's surface water resources, Section 5 of the Clean Water Act provides for the designation by the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) in coordination with the National Water Resources Board (NWRB) of certain areas as Water Quality Management Areas (WQMA) using appropriate physiographic unit such

as watershed, river basins or water resources regions, and that said management areas shall have similar hydrological, meteorological or geographical, biological reactions and diffusions of pollutants in the water bodies, or otherwise share common interest or face similar development programs and prospects;

WHEREAS, Amburayan River System and its tributaries and watershed have similar hydrological, hydrogeological, meteorological or geographic conditions which affect the physiocochemical,, biological and bacteriological reactions and diffusions of pollutants in the water bodies;

WHEREAS, Amburayan Water system and its tributaries and watershed include areas in the Municipality of Tublay, Kapangan, Kibungan, Buguias, Bakun, and Atok, all in the Province of Benguet, that traverses the Provinces of La Union and Ilocos Sur, then drain to the West Philippine Sea has a direct and long term impact on the socioeconomic and ecological well-being of the individuals, communities, businesses, agriculture and other stakeholders within the river system;

WHEREAS, Amburayan Water System is a potential source of water in the future for households, industries and commercial establishment in addition to the present daily uses for aquaculture, agriculture, and other domestic uses;

WHEREAS, the present state of the water quality of the Amburayan River System requires protection and management actions by Local Government Units and various stakeholders located within the watershed, working singly and collaboratively, to ensure the River System's sustainability and generate maximum benefits and welfare to the communities and stakeholders:

WHEREAS, the Jaime V. Ongpin Foundation, Inc. (JVOFI) and the Environmental Management Bureau-CAR and Region 1, in partnership with all Government Units within the Amburayan River System, national government agencies, industries, academe, non-government organizations and other stakeholders, has conducted a series of meeting and consultations and information dissemination activities on the Amburayan River System to generate and ensure understanding and support for its designation as a Water Quality Management Area;

WHEREAS, recognizing the importance of proper management and sustainable development of the Amburayan River System and its current and potential contributions to the social and economic development of its citizens and communities, the Municipalities of Tublay, Kapangan, Kibungan, Buguias, Bakun and Atok, all in the Province of Benguet consistently and actively participated in the planning and policy discussion about the Amburayan River System in preparation for its designation as a Water Quality Management Area and for this purpose, has created a local Water Quality Task Force;

WHEREAS, in consideration of the economic and ecological importance of the Amburayan River System watershed to the people and communities, the Province of Benguet affirms the need for collaborative action with other LGU's, other government agencies, academe, industry, agriculture, and service sector and NGO's in the areas recognizing that the actions and activities of one affect the others;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, be it

RESOLVED, as it is hereby done, to recommend to the Secretary of Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR CAR) thru the Environment Management Bureau, Cordillera Administrative Region, the designation of the Amburayan Water System as Water Quality Management Area pursuant to Republic Act No. 9275, otherwise known as the Clean Water Act of 2004;
