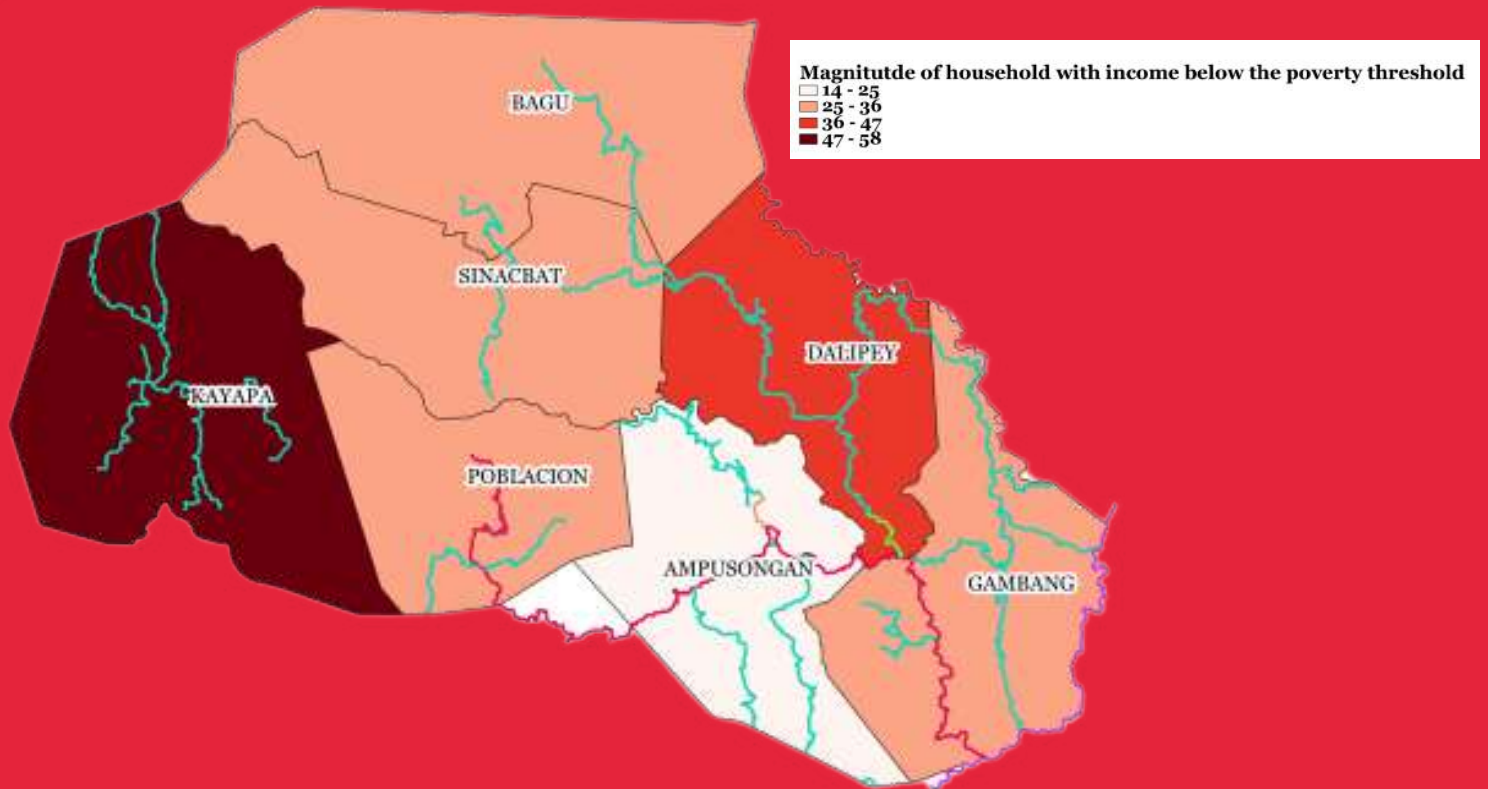

MAGNITUDE OF HOUSEHOLDS WITH INCOME BELOW THE POVERTY THRESHOLD

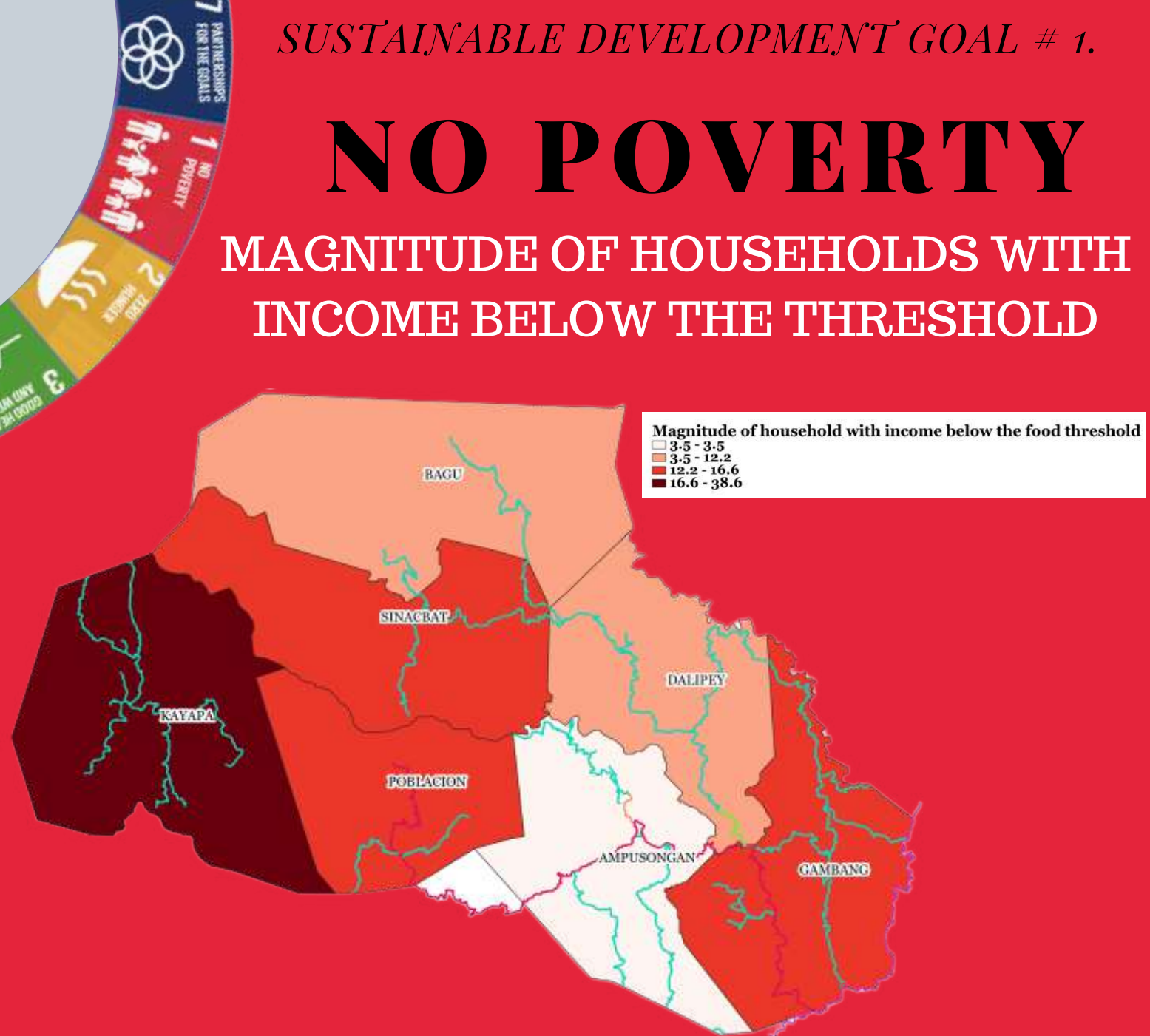


Barangay Kayapa has the highest magnitude of household with income below the poverty threshold followed by barangay Dalipey, Sinacbat, Gambang, Poblacion and Bagu which are 57.5, 41.5, 34.8, 33.5, 33, and 27.5 respectively while barangay Ampusongan has the lowest recorded magnitude of 14.3.

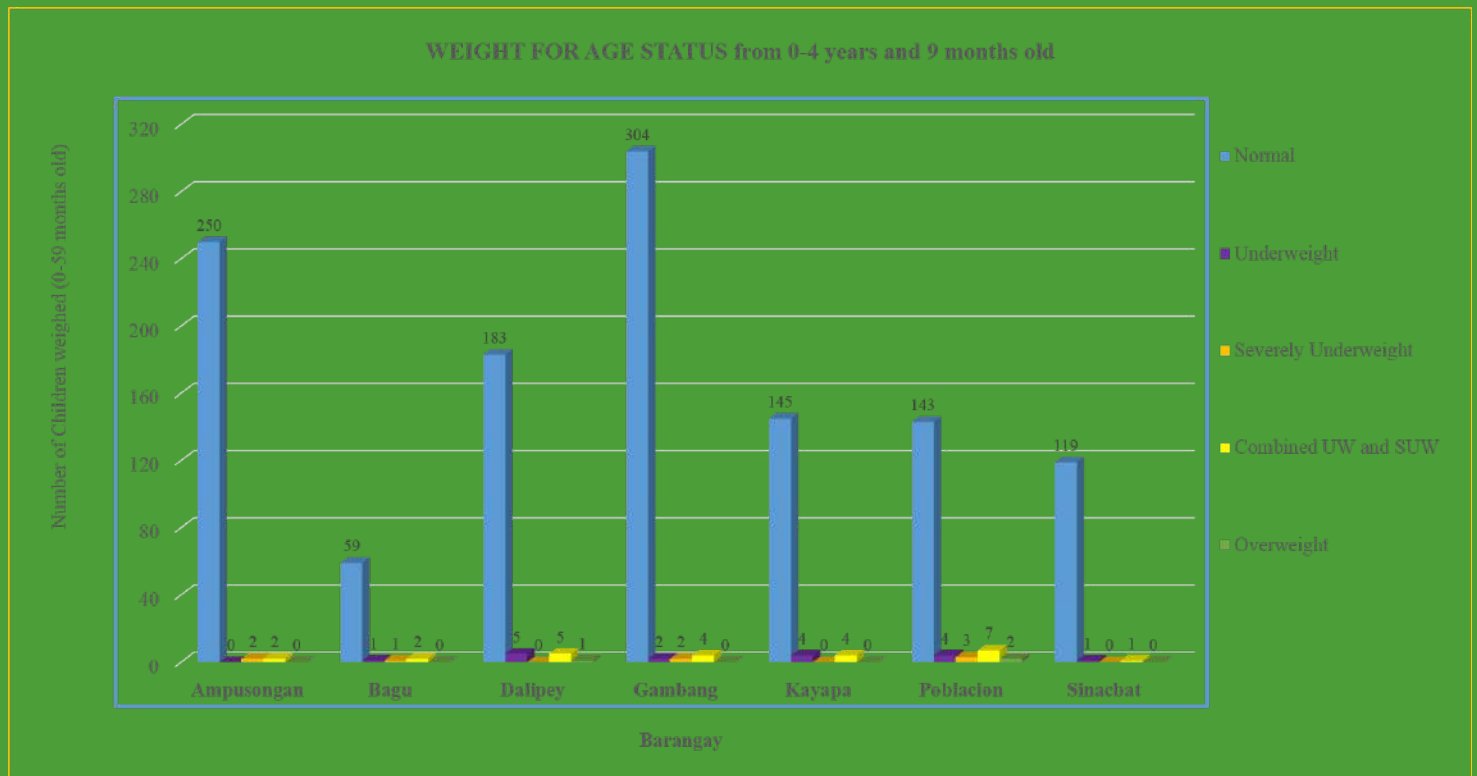
MAGNITUDE OF HOUSEHOLDS WITH INCOME BELOW THE THRESHOLD



In the households income below the food threshold barangay Kayapa has the highest recorded magnitude followed by barangay Sinacbat, Gambang, Poblacion, Bagu, and Dalipey which are 38.6, 16.6, 14.8, 13.8, 12.2, 11.5 respectively. Again barangay Ampusongan recorded the lowest magnitude of 3.5 below the food threshold. What is the Food threshold of Bakun?

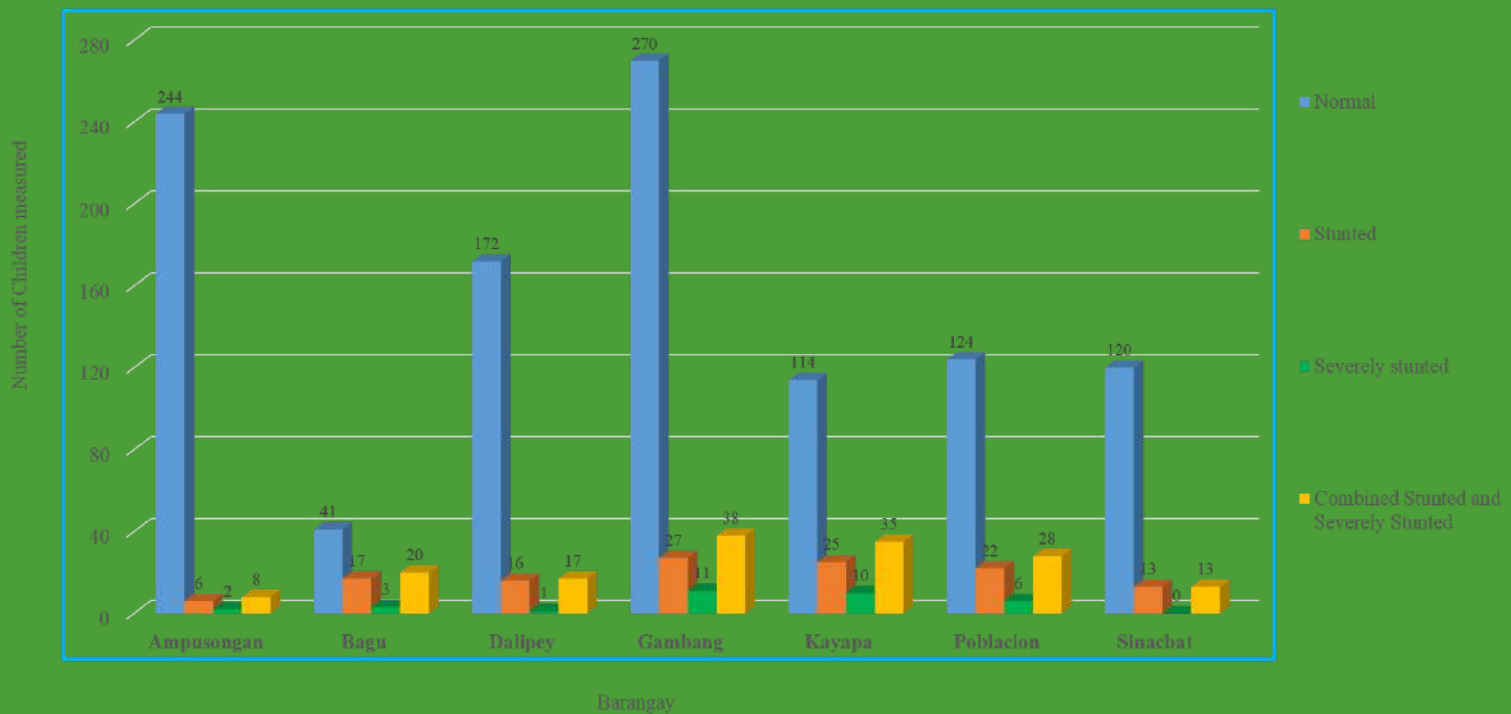

HEIGHT FOR AGE STATUS from 0-4 years and 9 months old

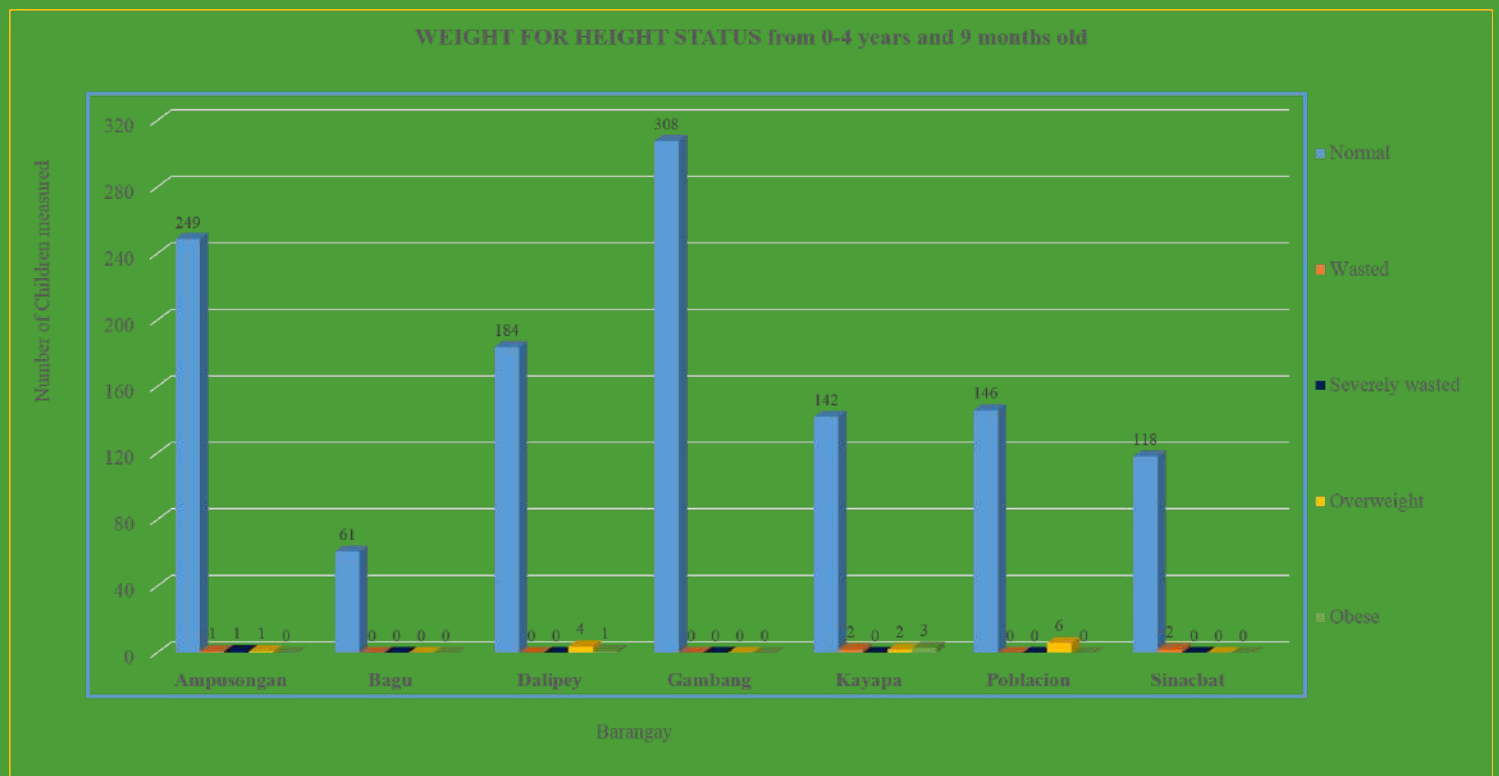

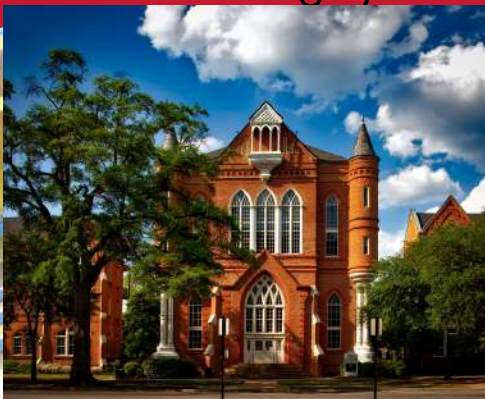

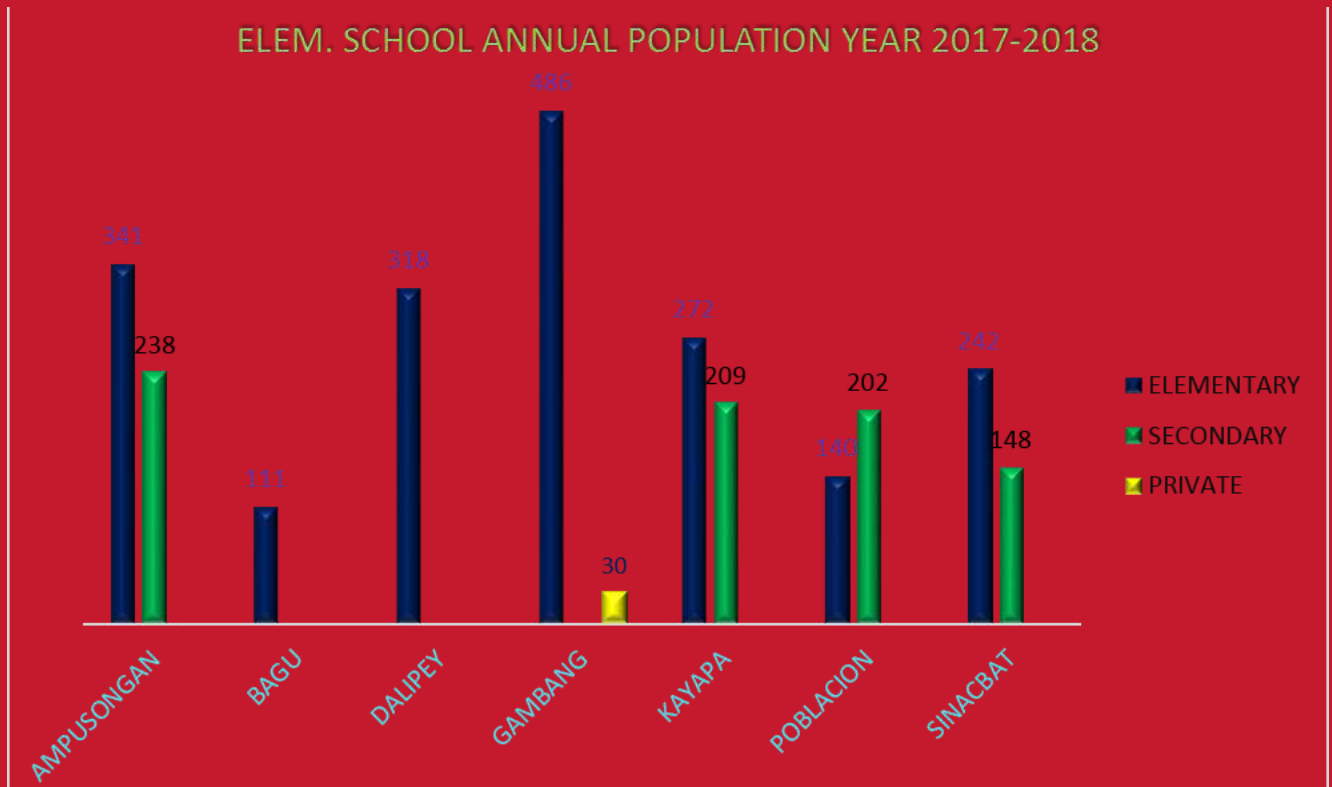

STATUS OF BAKUN SCHOOLS

Currently the municipality of Bakun has a total of 34 school primary, elementary, secondary. Bakun has four (4) Secondary schools, twenty nine (29) Primary and Elementary, and One Private school. There are still Five elementary schools can be reach by foot two in barangay Kayapa, two schools in barangay Bagu, and One in barangay Sinacbat.

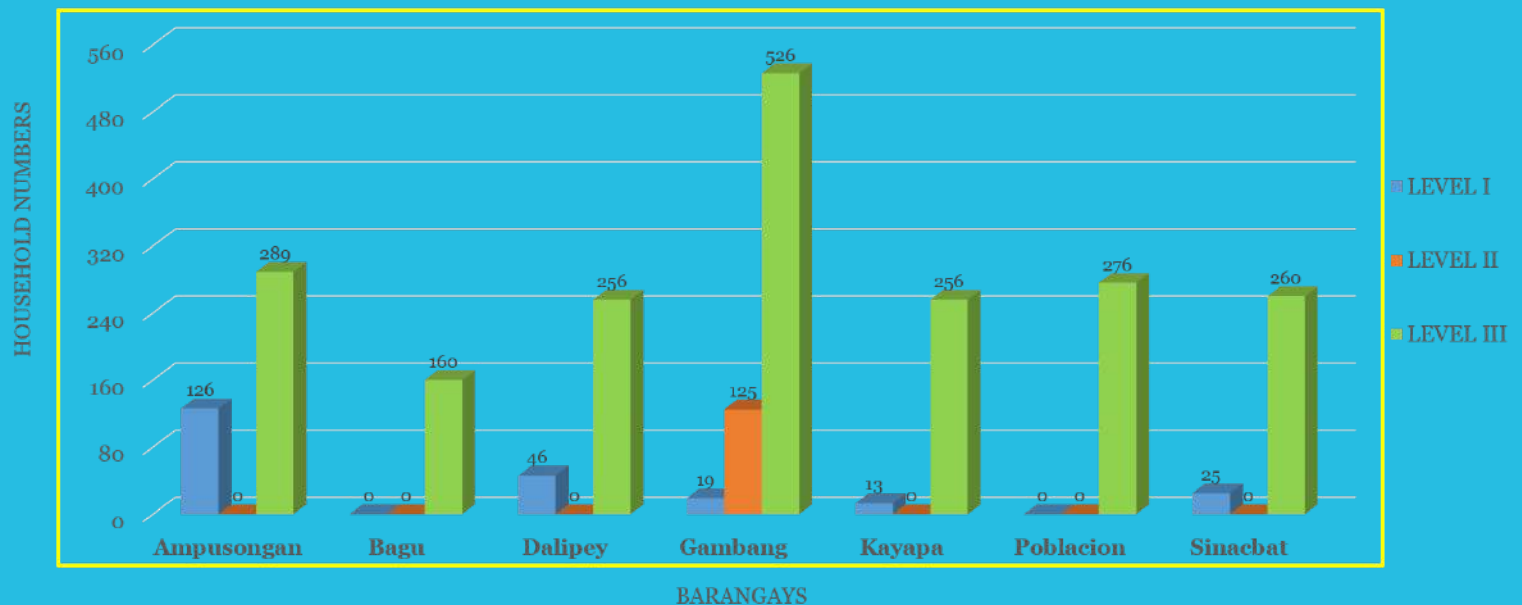

Level 1- potable water has to be fetch to the natural spring or creeks and rivers.

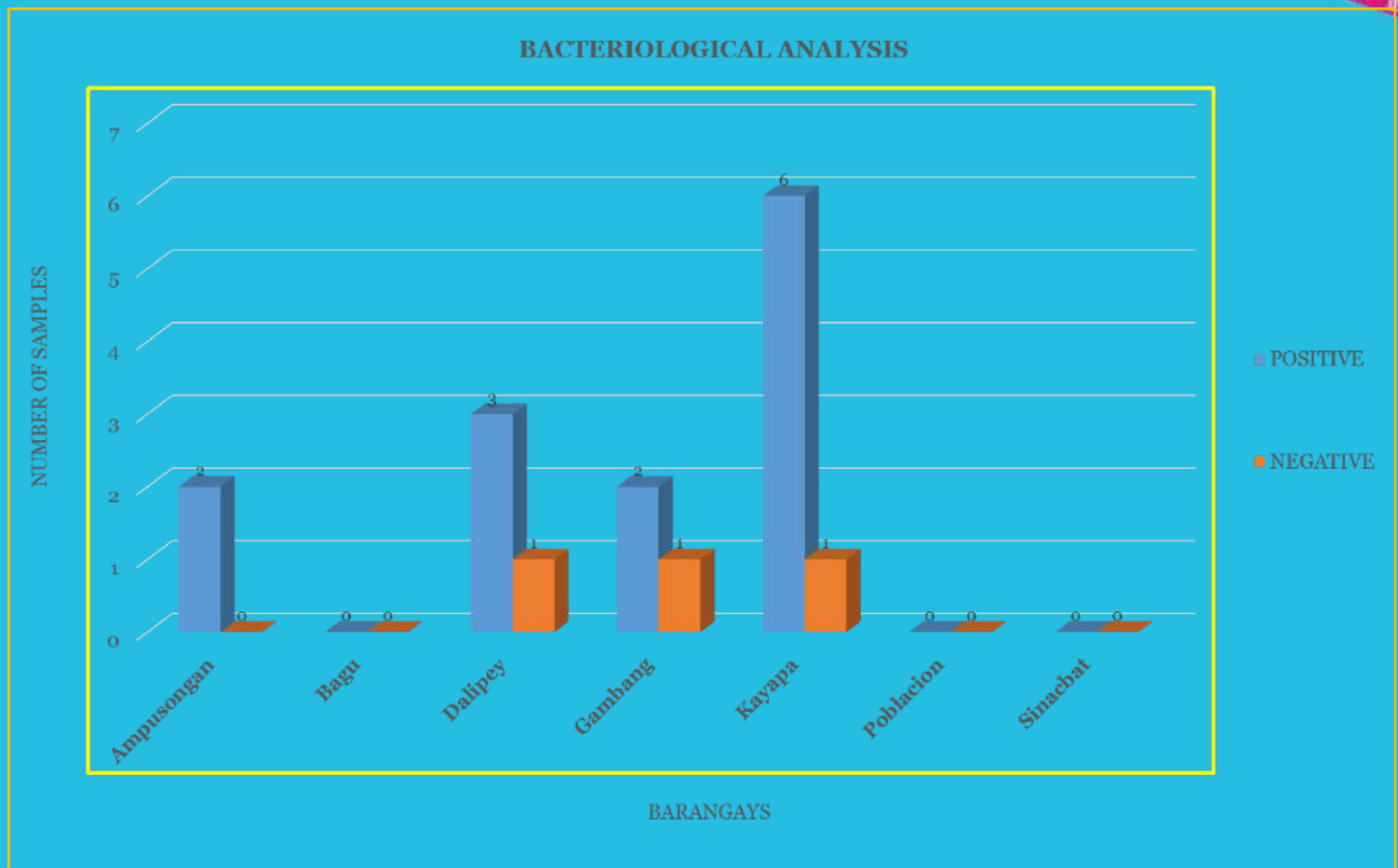
Level 2- water is available to a common outlet like deep wells and water tanks.

The results of Bacteriological analysis conducted by the personnel of MHO shows that barangay Kayapa out of the seven samples from their water source six tested positive with bacteria followed by barangay Dalipey 3 tested positive, barangay Ampusongan and Gambang with two positive results.

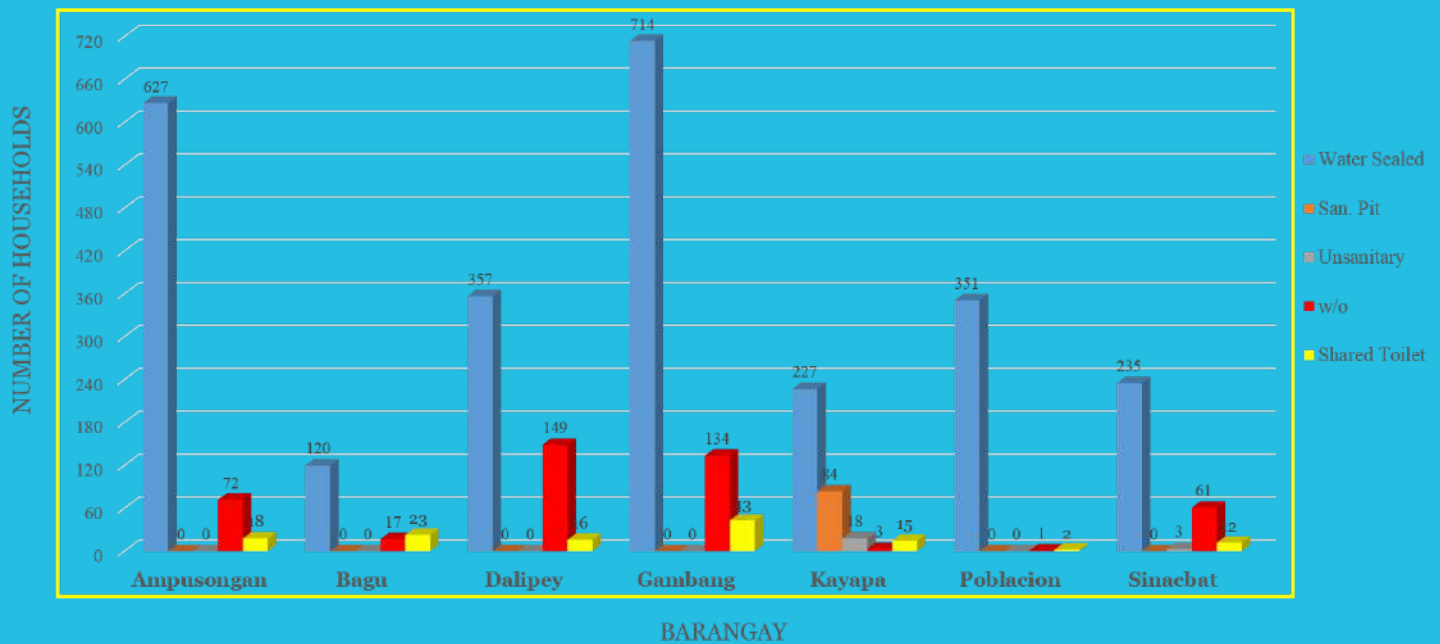
