Urban poverty rate is the percentage of the urban population living below the national poverty line (or in cases where a separate, urban poverty line is used, the urban poverty line)

Poverty Incidence is the proportion of individuals with per capita income less than the poverty thresholds.

Method of Computation

The formula for calculating the proportion of the total, urban and rural population living below the national poverty line, or headcount index, is as follows:

$$P_0 = \frac{1}{N} \sum_{i=1}^N I(y_i < z) = \frac{N_p}{N}$$

Where $I(.)$

is an indicator function that takes on a value of 1 if the bracketed expression is true, and 0 otherwise. If individual consumption or income is less than the national poverty line (for example, in absolute terms the line could be the price of a consumption bundle or in relative terms a percentage of the income distribution), then $I(.)$ is equal to 1 and the individual is counted as poor.

N_p is the total, urban or rural number of poor. N is the total, urban or rural population.

where:

P= proportion of population living below the national poverty line

Q = number of families/individuals with per capita annual income/expenditure less than the per capita annual poverty threshold

n = total number of families/individuals
